It is illegal to place any of the above listed items in any City Sanitary Service (CSS) container. Failure to comply will result in a minimum fine of \$500 plus the cost of removal and any legal fines associated with the contamination. Contact Tillamook County Solid Waste (503) 815-3975 for details about disposing of these or other hazardous waste items.

If you plan to have any construction debris in your box, then additional requirements must be met. Concrete or soil must not exceed half full in a 20 yard box due to load capacity limits. Tire(s) disposal and medical waste costs are extra and must be held out of the load. Please notify CCS before service begins.

**LOAD HEIGHT MUST NOT GO ABOVE RIM OF BOX
TAILGATE MUST CLOSE PROPERLY
MAXIMUM WEIGHT: 13 yard box = 5,000 LBS
MAXIMUM WEIGHT: 20 or 30 yard box = 15,000 LBS**

CONDITIONS:

The Lessee agrees to the conditions included on this document including the list of prohibited items. Lessee agrees to pay Lessor for all services rendered and any loss of or damage to said container due to fire, theft or careless destruction beyond normal use.

Lessee assumes liability for damages to public or private property, hard surface roads or driveways which might occur during the loading or unloading of container. Lessee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Lessor from any and all damages, costs, attorney's fees and/or liability of any kind resulting from the use by the Lessee of said container. Lessee agrees to reimburse City Sanitary Service for all attorney's fees, court costs, and other expense incurred by said company to enforce collection or to serve their rights under this agreement.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE ACCEPTANCE FORM

To protect the health and safety of our employees and customers, all loads of construction, remodeling and demolition waste brought to Tillamook County transfer stations are screened before, during and after unloading for materials that may contain asbestos. This form is required for all such loads of waste that contain construction and demolition waste.

Analytical test results are required for the following products commonly known to contain asbestos:

- **Interior walls and ceilings:** acoustical tiles, glue dots, plaster, and textured surfaces
- **Exterior walls:** cement siding, stucco
- **Flooring:** vinyl tiles, sheet vinyl, some mastic adhesives
- **Insulation/fireproofing:** block, boiler, spray-applied, vermiculite, monokote, sink undercoating, thermal system insulation (fiberglass, cellulose, and mineral wool are exempt)
- **Gaskets:** furnace, mechanical, boiler, wood stove (automotive gaskets are exempt)
- **Heating:** white paper or seam tape on ducts, air-duct cement and insulation
- **Roofing materials:** tar paper, felt, silver/white roofing paint, Nicolite paper
- **Fire doors, fire/kiln brick and fireproofing**
- **Various compounds:** window glazing, adhesives, caulks, patching, mastics, vapor barrier products (plastic or synthetic materials such as Tyvek are exempt)
- **Electrical:** switch gear, circuit boxes and fuse panels; wiring with cloth insulation (Romex wiring is exempt)

PLEASE NOTE: Flat/built-up roofing is not accepted for shingles recycling even if customers present negative analytical test results.

INSTRUCTIONS

- **This form is required for all loads containing construction, remodeling or demolition debris.**
- This form should be completed by the person responsible for and knowledgeable about the contents of the load.
- For multiple-load projects, copies of this form will be accepted, but the contents of the load must match the description of the waste materials on the form.

All parties involved (generator, contractor and hauler) may be **held responsible for the abatement of positive (greater than one percent asbestos by weight) asbestos-containing materials unloaded at Metro's transfer stations, including but not limited to the costs for testing, a licensed abatement contractor, fines and administration.**
